THAT ARE MOST FREQUENTLY CITED BY COMPLIANCE SAFETY
AND HEALTH OFFICERS DURING WORKPLACE INSPECTIONS**

No or inadequate written employee Hazard Communication program	29 CFR 1910.147
Personal protective equipment- Hazard assessment and equipment selection	29 CFR 1910.132
Personal protective equipment – No written certification of hazard assessment	29 CFR 1910.132
No or improper personal protective equipment	29 CFR 1910.132
Respiratory protection – Failure to establish a written program	29 CFR 1910.134
Respiratory protection – Failure to provide medical evaluations prior to fit test and respirator use	29 CFR 1910.134
No Lock Out / Tag Out procedures	29 CFR 1910.147
Failure to follow general electrical safety requirements	29 CFR 1910.331-335
Denied access to employee medical records	29 CFR 1910.1020
No or incomplete OSHA 200 illness & injury log	29 CFR 1904
